JULY 2010

SCHOOLS OF INSTRUCTION/WORKSHOPS - District Presidents **MUST** hold a School of Instruction for their district. Encourage all to attend. Presidents, officers, chairman and members are urged to attend the state Training Seminar in their area.

AUGUST 2010

Veterans & Family Support - Visit nursing homes, hospitals, support seniors and work Veteran's Program. Voice of Democracy, Patriot's Pen and Patriotic Art information should now be in schools.

SEPTEMBER 2010

Hospital Month – Send 50¢ per member, more if possible, based on June 30, 2010 membership. Observe Patriot's Day September 11th, POW/MIA Recognition Day September 18th, Gold Star Mother's Day, September 27th.

OCTOBER 2010

Health and Happiness – Send 10¢ per member, more if possible, based on June 30, 2010 membership.

Cancer Aid & Research – Send \$2.00 per member, more if possible, based on June 30, 2010 membership. Participate in Veterans Day November 11th, and do something special for the needy on Thanksgiving – November 25th.

DECEMBER 2010

Hold parties for seniors and/or youth. Take food baskets to those in need. Take part in special programs for underprivileged children.

JANUARY 2011

State Nursing Scholarship – Send \$15.00, more if possible, to the State Nursing Scholarship Fund.

FEBRUARY 2011

Salute to Hospitalized Veterans Week February 7-13, VFW Foundation Fund – Send a donation of \$5.00 or more

MARCH 2011

VFW PAC – Hold a fundraiser for PAC – earmark the check “Special Fundraiser VFW/PAC”

APRIL 2011

National Volunteer Week – April 19-24. Take part in local Walk-A-Thon, visit hospitals, nursing homes, and assist elderly persons.
